

Summer Driving Directions from Golden to Amiskwi Lodge

| Total Km | Landmarks | Comments | Go this far (km) |

| 00.0 | Start at Husky Gas Station in Golden, B.C. | Set your odometer to 0. It is a 144 km round trip so check your gas gauge before leaving Golden. | |
| | Drive West on Highway 1 | Km measurement can differ from vehicle to vehicle | 10.3 |
| 10.3 | Turn Right on Moberly Branch Road | | 2.1 |
| 12.4 | Turn Left on Golden Donald Upper Road | | 0.9 |
| 13.3 | Veer Right onto the Oberg Johnson Road | | 1.7 |
| 15.0 | Turn Left onto Moberly School Road | | 0.7 |
| 15.7 | Veer Right onto Blaeberry Road | | 6.7 |
| 22.4 | Turn Left across the bridge over the Blaeberry River and follow the Forestry Trunk Road | Driving straight 300 m instead of crossing the bridge will get you to the helicopter staging area, used for winter access and summer special request access to the lodge. | 6.7 |
| 29.1 | | Thompson Falls. A scenic picnic spot on the Blaeberry River. The yellow rectangular shaped signs with a number on them are for the logging trucks to know how many km they are from the Blaeberry bridge. | 6.4 |
| 35.5 | | Split Creek Recreation Site. Picnic tables and rest stop | 18.5 |
| 54.0 | Cross the Mummery Creek Bridge | The Mummery Glacier is off to your left. There is a campground on the RHS immediately after the bridge. | 1.5 |
| 55.5 | | Road to the Mummery Glacier Trail on LHS. This scenic hike takes a couple of hours, or spend all day! | 1.3 |
| 56.8 | Turn Right across the bridge over the Blaeberry River | This is the last time you will cross the Blaeberry River. Follow road up 15 km of switchbacks. It is a bumpy but very scenic drive. It is a good idea to have an axe or saw in your car in case of fallen trees. You never know! | 0.9 |
| 57.7 | Take the Left road | The road to the right is a new logging road | 6.8 |
| 64.5 | Veer Right at the fork in the road | If you go straight ahead you will end up on the Collie Creek Road | 7.6 |
| 72.1 | You made it! | Park your vehicle in the staging area surrounded by chicken wire. This is to keep the porcupines out (they love rubber gas lines!) Put your hikers on and load up your packs. Follow the trail at the south end of the parking area. It takes about 40 minutes to get up the hill to Amiskwi Lodge. | |
